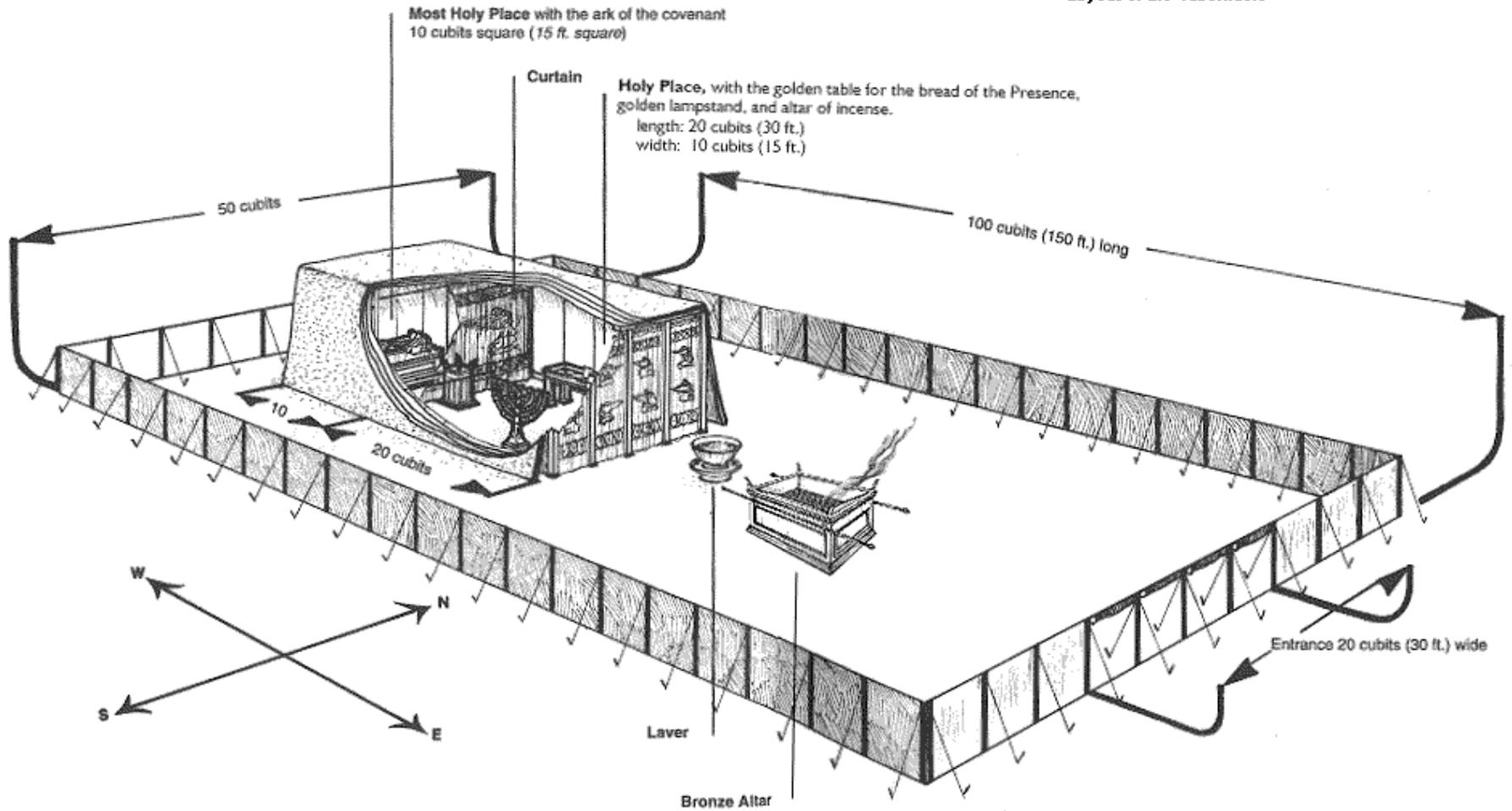


## Layout of the Tabernacle



# Levitical Sacrifices and Offerings

Burnt Offering	Substitutionary judgment	
Meal (Tribute) Offering	Bloodless; the value of Christ's death	Memorial to God's grace
Peace Offering	Fellowship	Shared meal celebrates peace with God
Sin Offering	Forgiveness	Purification for unintentional sin
Guilt Offering	Forgiveness	Purification for specific sin

Ex. 30:17, “The LORD spoke to Moses, saying,  
Ex. 30:18, “ ‘You shall also make a laver  
[rwñø¥yl;k, *kiyyor*] of bronze, with its base  
of bronze, for washing [**XAjər** (raæhΩasΩ) ;  
and you shall put it between the tent of  
meeting and the altar, and  
you shall put water in it.’ ”



**Ex. 30:19**, “ ‘Aaron and his sons shall wash [LXX-ni÷ptw *nipto*] their hands and their feet from it;

**Ex. 30:20**, “ ‘when they enter the tent of meeting, they shall wash [LXX-*nipto*] with water, so that they will not die; or when they approach the altar to minister, by offering up in smoke a fire *sacrifice* to the LORD.’ ”

**Ex. 30:21, “ ‘So they shall wash their hands and their feet, so that they will not die; and it shall be a perpetual statute for them, for Aaron and his descendants throughout their generations.’**

**Ex. 38:8, “Moreover, he made the laver of bronze with its base of bronze, from the mirrors of the serving women who served at the doorway of the tent of meeting.”**

**Ex. 40:7**, “And you shall set the laver between the tabernacle of meeting and the altar, and put water in it.”



**Ex. 40:12**, “Then you shall bring Aaron and his sons to the door of the tabernacle of meeting and wash [louo-“bathe”] them with water.

**Ex. 40:13**, “You shall put the holy garments on Aaron, and anoint him and consecrate him, that he may minister to Me as priest.”

**John 13:5**, “After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash [ni÷ptw (*niptoœ*)] the disciples’ feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded.

**John 13:6**, “Then He came to Simon Peter. And Peter said to Him, ‘Lord, are You washing my feet?’

**John 13:7**, “Jesus answered and said to him, ‘What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will know after this.’ ”

John 13:8, “Peter said to Him, “‘You shall never wash my feet!’ Jesus answered him, ‘If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me.’”

John 13:9, “Simon Peter said to Him, ‘Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head!’”

John 13:10, “Jesus said to him, ‘He who is bathed [louw (*louoœ*)] needs only to wash [*nipto*] his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you.’”

John 13:11, “For He knew who would betray Him; therefore He said, ‘You are not all **clean** [*katharos* positionally clean, i.e., saved].’ ”
