Philippians 3:5, “circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew born of Hebrews”

Galatians 1:13, 14, “For you have heard of my previous way of life in Judaism, how intensely I persecuted the church of God and tried to destroy it. I was advancing in Judaism beyond many Jews of my own age and was extremely zealous for the traditions of my fathers.”

Gen. 3:15, “And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.”

Gal. 4:4, “But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law,”

Key Messianic Prophecies Fulfilled by Jesus Born of a Virgin

Isa. 7:14, “Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.”

Matt. 1:18, “Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit.”

“Seed of Abraham”

Gen. 22:18, “In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.”

Matt. 1:1, “The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham:”
Gal. 3:16, “Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, ‘And to seeds,’ as of many, but as of one, ‘And to your Seed,’ who is Christ.”

Key Messianic Prophecies Fulfilled by Jesus Descendant from Jacob

Num. 24:17, “I see Him, but not now; I behold Him, but not near; a Star shall come out of Jacob; a Scepter shall rise out of Israel, and batter the brow of Moab, and destroy all the sons of tumult.”

art. Aor pass ptcp. “determine, appoint”

relative clause parallel to the birth
