Col. 1:5**

Col. 1:3, “We always give thanks to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you,

Col. 1:4, “since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of your love for all the saints;

Col. 1:5, “because of the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, of which you heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel,”

Enhanced translation:

We always give thanks to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ when we pray for you

- 1. Because we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and**
- 2. Your love for all the saints**
 - a. because of the hope which is laid up for you in heaven.**


Hope







Rom. 5:2, “through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in [on the basis of] hope of the glory of God.”

Rom. 5:3, “And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance;

Rom. 5:4, “and perseverance, character; and character, hope.

Rom. 5:5, “Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.”

**Rom. 8:24, “For we were saved in this hope, but

still hope for what he sees?**

**Rom. 8:25, “But if we hope for what we do not
see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance.”**

Rom. 8:18, “For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

Rom. 8:20, “For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope;

Rom. 8:21, “because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

Rom. 8:22, “For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now.”

Rom. 8:23, “Not only that, but we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body.”

Rom. 8:24, “For we were saved [fut aor—we will be sanctified] in this hope [by means of this hope], but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees?

Rom. 8:25, “But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance.”

1 Th. 1:3, “remembering without ceasing your work of faith, labor of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father,”

2 Th. 1:3, “We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is fitting, because your faith grows exceedingly, and the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other.”

Eph. 1:15, “Therefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints,”

Philem. 5, “hearing of your love and faith which you have toward the Lord Jesus and toward all the saints,”

Rom. 15:13, “Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.”
