

Examples of everyday use of eiserchomai

Matt. 2:21, "Then he arose, took the young Child and His mother, and <u>came into</u> the land of Israel."

Matt. 6:6, "But you, when you pray, <u>go into</u> your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly."

Matt. 8:5, "Now when Jesus <u>had entered</u> Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, pleading with Him," Matt. 12:45, "Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and <u>they enter</u> [*ElSerchomai*] and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse than the first. So shall it also be with this wicked generation."
