Structure:

Matt. 19:1–25:46 Matt. 19:3, "The Pharisees also came to Him, [in order to] testing Him, and saying to Him, 'Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for just any reason?'" Gittim 9:10 A The House of Shammai say,

"A man should divorce his wife only because he has found grounds for it in unchastity,

B "since it is said, Because he has found in her indecency in anything (Deut. 24:)."

C And the House of Hillel say, "Even if she spoiled his dish,

D "since it is said, Because he has found in her indecency in anything."

E R. Aqiba says, "Even if he found someone else prettier than she,

F "since it is said, And it shall be if she find no favor in his eyes (Deut. 24:1)."

- Giving a husband untithed food
- Uttering a vow and not fulfilling it
- Going out in public with her hair unbound
- Speaking with any man in public
