

Saved from the Presence of Sin <u>1 Pet. 1:6</u>, "In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by <u>various trials</u>,

<u>1 Pet. 1:7</u>, "that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is <u>tested by fire</u>, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ,

<u>1 Pet. 1:8,</u> "whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory,

<u>1Pet. 1:9</u> receiving the end of your faith—the salvation of your souls.

Enhanced translation:

when you receive the end result of your trusting God-the deliverance of your life *in the midst of your trials.* <u>1 Pet. 1:10</u>, "Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace that would come to you,

<u>1 Pet. 1:11</u>, "searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow.

<u>1 Pet. 1:12</u>, "To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things which angels desire to look into." <u>1 Pet. 1:10,</u> "Of <u>this salvation</u> the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace that would come to you,

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ἐπιθυμέω epithumeō pres act indic 3 plur to desire Luke 15:7, "I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance."

Luke 15:10, "Likewise, I say to you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents." <u>1 Tim. 3:16</u>, "And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifested in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen by angels, preached among the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up in glory." <u>1 Cor. 4:9</u>, "For I think that God has displayed us, the apostles, last, as men condemned to death; for we have been made a spectacle to the world, both to angels and to men." <u>Eph. 3:10</u>, "to the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places," <u>1 Tim. 5:21</u>, "I charge you before God and the Lord Jesus Christ and the elect angels that you observe these things without prejudice, doing nothing with partiality."
