MUEL THE BATTLE IS THE LORD'S GOD SAVES BY FEW OR MANY 1 SAMUEL 13:14-14:15



<u>1 Sam. 13:5</u>, "Then the Philistines gathered together to fight with Israel, <u>thirty</u> <u>thousand chariots</u> and <u>six thousand</u> <u>horsemen</u>, and people as the sand which is on the seashore in multitude. And they came up and encamped in Michmash, to the east of Beth Aven."

Radovan/<u>www.BibleLandPictures.com0</u> <u>1 Sam. 13:6</u>, "When the men of Israel saw that they were in danger (for the people were <u>distressed [oppressed, under</u> <u>pressure]</u>), then the people <u>hid in caves, in</u> <u>thickets, in rocks, in holes, and in pits</u>.

<u>1 Sam. 13:7</u>, "And some of the Hebrews crossed over the Jordan to the land of Gad and Gilead. As for Saul, he was still in Gilgal, and all the people followed him trembling." <u>1 Sam. 13:13</u>, "And Samuel said to Saul, 'You have done foolishly. You have not kept the commandment of the LORD your God, which He commanded you. For now the LORD would have established your kingdom over Israel forever.

<u>1 Sam. 13:14</u>, "'But now your kingdom shall not continue. The LORD has sought for Himself <u>a man after His own heart</u>, and the LORD has commanded him to be commander over His people, because you have not kept what the LORD commanded you.'" "according to His own heart"

<u>1 Sam. 2:35</u>, "Then I will raise up for Myself a faithful priest who shall do <u>according to what</u> is in My heart and in My mind. I will build him a sure house, and he shall walk before My anointed forever."

<u>1 Sam. 16:7</u>, "But the LORD said to Samuel, 'Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, <u>but</u> <u>the LORD looks at the heart</u>.'" <u>1 Sam. 13:15</u>, "Then Samuel arose and went up from Gilgal to Gibeah of Benjamin. And Saul numbered the people present with him, about six hundred men."

<u>1 Sam. 13:17,</u> "Then raiders came out of the camp of the Philistines in three companies. One company turned onto <u>the</u> <u>road to Ophrah</u>, to the land of Shual,

<u>1 Sam. 13:18</u>, "another company turned to <u>the road to Beth Horon</u>, and another company turned to the road of the border that <u>overlooks the Valley of Zeboim</u> toward the wilderness."



<u>1 Sam. 13:19</u>, "Now there was no blacksmith to be found throughout all the land of Israel, for the Philistines said, 'Lest the Hebrews make swords or spears.'

1 Sam. 13:20, "But all the Israelites would go down to the Philistines to sharpen each man's plowshare, his mattock, his ax, and his sickle;"



<u>1 Sam. 13:21</u>, "and the charge for a sharpening was a pim for the plowshares, the mattocks, the forks, and the axes, and to set the points of the goads."



Judg. 1:6, "Then Adoni-Bezek fled, and they pursued him and caught him and cut off his thumbs and big toes.

Judg. 1:7, "And Adoni-Bezek said, 'Seventy kings with their thumbs and big toes cut off used to gather scraps under my table; as I have done, so God has repaid me.' Then they brought him to Jerusalem, and there he died."

<u>1 Sam. 13:23</u>, "And the garrison of the Philistines went out to the pass of Michmash."

<u>1 Sam. 14:1</u>, "Now it happened one day that Jonathan the son of Saul said to the young man who bore his armor, 'Come, let us go over to the Philistines' garrison that is on the other side.' But he did not tell his father.

<u>1 Sam. 14:2</u>, "And Saul was sitting in the outskirts of Gibeah ["on top of a hill" *LXX*] under a pomegranate tree which is in Migron. The people who were with him were about six hundred men."



<u>1 Sam. 14:3, "Ahijah</u> the son of Ahitub, Ichabod's brother, the son of Phinehas, the son of Eli, the LORD'S priest in Shiloh, was wearing an ephod. But the people did not know that Jonathan had gone."



<u>1 Sam. 14:4</u>, "Between the passes, by which Jonathan sought to go over to the Philistines' garrison, there was a sharp rock on one side and a sharp rock on the other side. And the name of one was Bozez ('slippery'), and the name of the other Seneh ('thorny')."

Discerning God's Will

<u>1 Sam. 14:8,</u> "Then Jonathan said, 'Very well, let us cross over to these men, and we will show ourselves to them.

<u>1 Sam. 14:9</u>, "If they say thus to us, 'Wait until we come to you,' then we will stand still in our place and not go up to them.

<u>1 Sam. 14:10</u>, "But if they say thus, 'Come up to us,' then we will go up. For the LORD has delivered them into our hand, and this will be a sign to us." <u>1 Sam. 14:11</u>, "So both of them showed themselves to the garrison of the Philistines. And the Philistines said, 'Look, the Hebrews are coming out of the holes where they have hidden.'

<u>1 Sam. 14:12</u>, "Then the men of the garrison called to Jonathan and his armorbearer, and said, 'Come up to us, and we will show you something.' Jonathan said to his armorbearer, 'Come up after me, for the LORD has delivered [given] them into the hand of Israel.'" <u>1 Sam. 14:12</u>, "Then the men of the garrison called to Jonathan and his armorbearer, and said, 'Come up to us, and we will show you something.' <u>1 Sam. 14:13</u>, "And Jonathan climbed up on his hands and knees with his armorbearer after him; and they fell before Jonathan. And as he came after him, his armorbearer killed them." <u>1 Sam. 14:14</u>, "That first slaughter which Jonathan and his armorbearer made was about twenty men within about half an acre of land.

<u>1 Sam. 14:15</u>, "And there was trembling in the camp, in the field, and among all the people. The garrison and the raiders also trembled; and the earth quaked, so that it was a very great trembling."
