

# GENESIS

**Book of Beginnings**

**Psa. 11:3 “If the foundations are  
destroyed, What can the righteous  
do?”**

**Acts 14:15 and saying, “Men, why are you doing these things? We are also men of the same nature as you, and preach the gospel to you in order that you should turn from these vain things to a living God, who made the heaven and the earth and the sea, and all that is in them.”**

**Acts 14:16 “And in the generations gone by He permitted all the nations to go their own ways;**

**Acts 14:17 and yet He did not leave Himself without witness, in that He did good and gave you rains from heaven and fruitful seasons, satisfying your hearts with food and gladness.”**

**Acts 14:18 And even saying these things, they with difficulty restrained the crowds from offering sacrifice to them.**

**“In antiquity there was a broad spectrum of attitudes toward the material world. At one end of the spectrum was pagan cosmic religion, constructed from a mixture of Pythagorean, Platonic, Aristotelian, and Stoic doctrines. This cosmic religion saw the material cosmos, or at least its upper heavenly part, as a perfect expression of divine creativity and providence, ‘the supreme manifestation of divinity,’ and indeed itself a divine being.”**
