


Revelation 19:12, "His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself."

## This love flows from three areas:

heart (Gr: kardia),

soul (Gr. psuche),

mind (Gr., dianoia).

**Kαρδία, kardia,** refers thus to the *inner person,* the seat of understanding, knowledge, and will, and takes on as well the meaning *conscience. Exegetical Dictionary of the New Testament.* 2:250.
