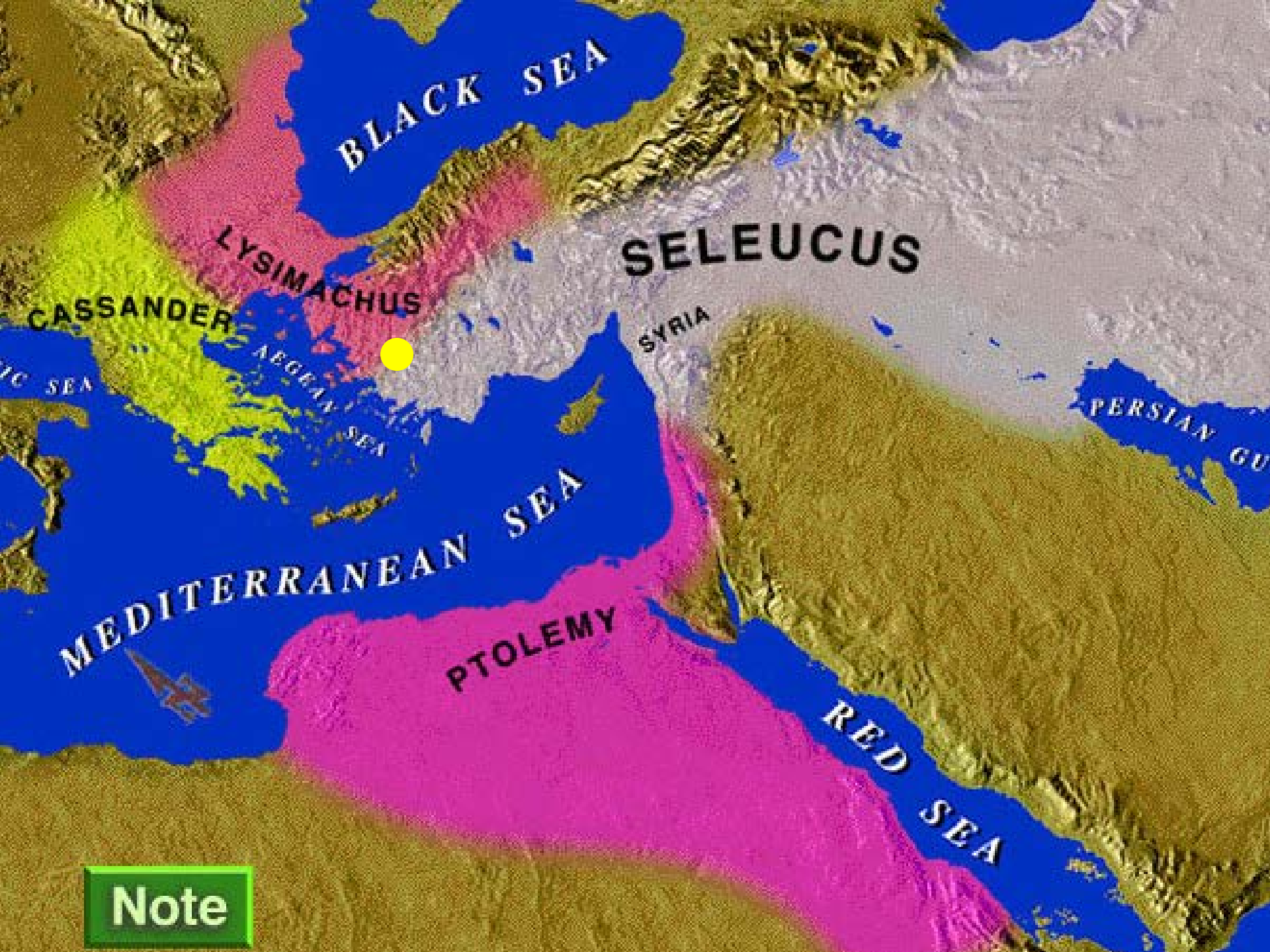

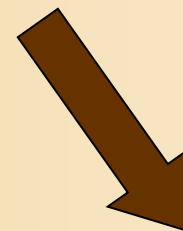
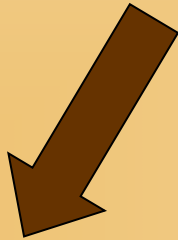

Matthew 22:36, “ ‘Teacher, which *is* the great commandment in the law?’

Matthew 22:37, “Jesus said to him, ‘You shall love the LORD your God with all your **heart**, with all your **soul**, and with all your **mind** [intellectual capacity].’

Matthew 22:38, “This is *the* first and great commandment.

Matthew 22:39, “And *the* second *is* like it: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ ”

This love flows from three areas:


heart (Gr: *kardia*),

soul (Gr. *psuche*),


mind (Gr., *dianoia*).

Καρδία, *kardia*, refers thus to the *inner person*, the seat of understanding, knowledge, and will, and takes on as well the meaning *conscience*. *Exegetical Dictionary of the New Testament*. 2:250.

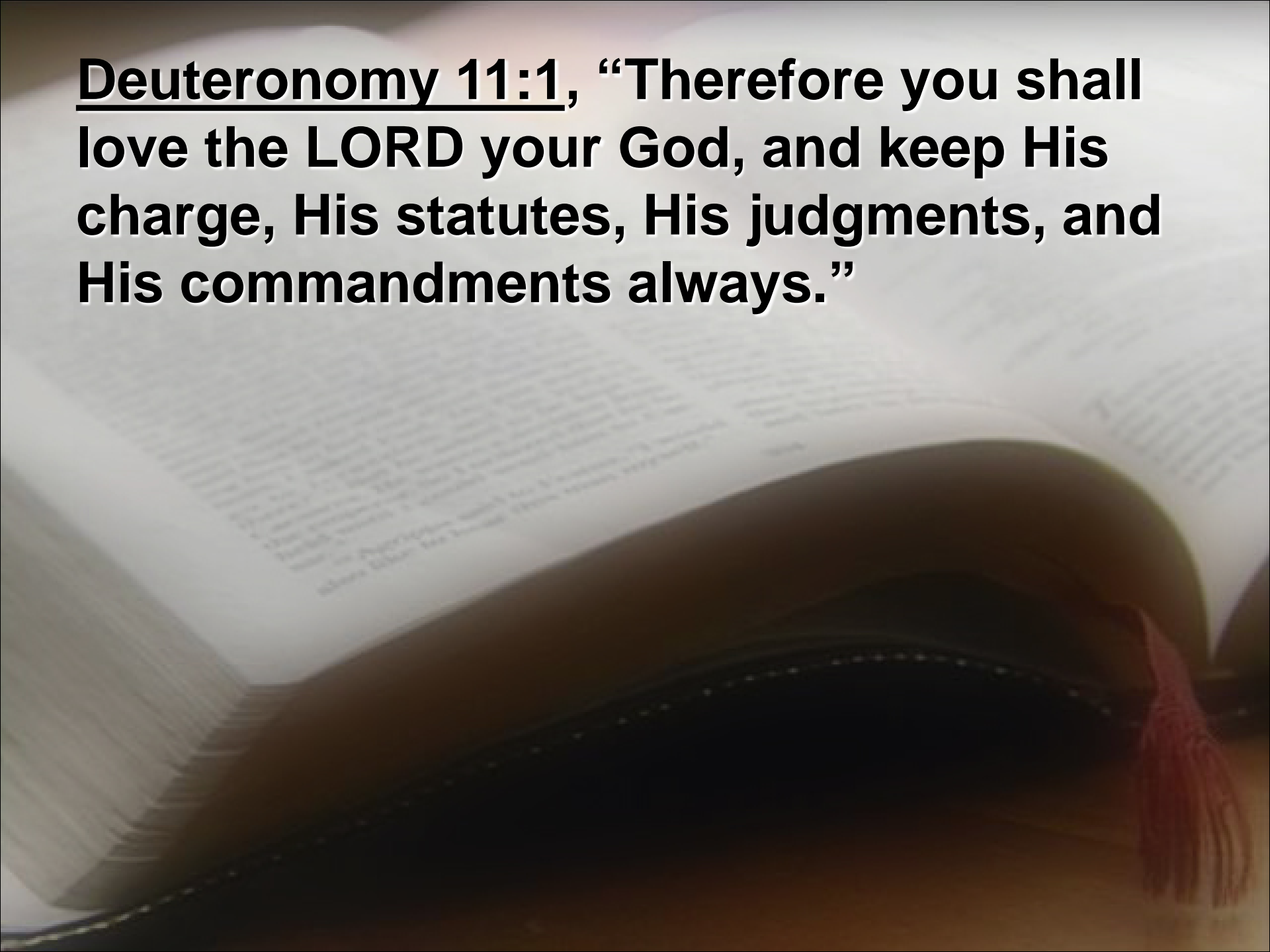
Deuteronomy 7:9, “Therefore know that the LORD your God, He *is* God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments;”



The Old Testament reiterates the mandate to “love your neighbor as yourself.” Lev. 19:18 is then quoted 7x in the New Testament (Matt. 5:43, 19:1, 22:39; Mark 12:31; Romans 13:9; Gal. 5:14; and James 2:8).



John 13:34, “A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

John 13:35, “By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.”
