CHAPTER 11

THE REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST, WHICH GOD GAVE UNTO him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass, and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John: who bare record of the word of God, and of the revelations of Jesus Christ, and of all things which he saw.

Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep these things, for the time is

Rev. 11:15, “Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying,

‘The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever.’”

Rev. 11:16, “And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God,”

God exists as a unity of essence, with three Persons. Each Person is distinct, without compromising the unity. God is one in essence and three in person.

Review: The Doctrine of *Perichoresis*

1. ***Perichoresis*** “interpenetration” (also called “circumincession”). In Trinitarian theology, intimate union, mutual indwelling, and mutual interpenetration of the three Members of the Trinity with one another so that each is always in the other two.

circumincession (also circuminsession)–In Christian theology the technical term for the interpenetration of the three Persons of the Holy Trinity. The corresponding Gk. word, περιχώρησις (lit. ‘a proceeding around’), used by St. John of Damascus in this connection, was rendered into Latin *circumincessio* by *Burgundio of Pisa* (d. 1193)

2. If you have seen one Person, you have seen all three because of the interpenetration of the other Members of the Godhead into one another. One figure on the Throne portrays the “unity” of Tri-Unity.

Deut. 6:4, “Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD is one!” [אֱחָד (achad), meaning a unity of plurals, not a singularity]

John 10:28, “and I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand.

ὀργίζω *orgizo*,

Aor Pas Ind 3p, “to become angry”

ὀργή *orgḗ*; wrath, anger

ὄργή *orgḗ*; covet after, desire. Wrath, anger as a state of mind.

Contrast *thumos*, indignation, wrath as the outburst of a vengeful mind.

Dan. 12:2, “Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace and everlasting contempt.”



James 1:12, “Blessed is a man who perseveres under trial; for once he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.”







Rev. 20:11, “Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them.

Rev. 20:12, “And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is *the book of life*; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.”
