




Table of Showbread: Christ the Bread of Life






Tabernacle altar of incense

Christ Our Propitiator





“The Ark of God” 34x

“The Ark of the Covenant of Yhwh” 31x

“Let them construct for Me a Sanctuary,
that I may dwell in their midst.”

Exodus 25:8



“And there I will meet with you; and from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim which are upon the ark of the testimony, I will speak to you about all that I will give you in commandment for the sons of Israel.

Exodus 25:22



אָרוֹן, *aron*, box, chest, coffin from arca L. not the same as תֵּבָה (tēbâ), nom. ark, basket for either Noah's barge or the papyrus basket the infant Moses was placed in.

“the ark of the testimony” (Ex. 25:22)

“the ark of the covenant of the Lord” (Num. 10:33), 31 times the Ark is called the ark of the covenant of Yahweh [the LORD]” (Deut 10:8, Judg. 20:27.), the name which means “I AM” (Exod 3:14, cf. vv. 12, 17), which in turn suggests the phrase.

“the ark of God” (1 Sam. 3:3); “the ark of the God of Israel” because of its association with deity.

“the ark of the Lord, the Lord of all the earth;” “the ark of the Lord God” (1 Ki. 2:26);

“the holy ark” (2 Chr. 35:3);

“the ark of Thy strength” (Ps. 132:8).

1 Pet. 1:18, “knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers,

1 Pet. 1:19, “but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.

1 Pet. 1:20, “For He was foreknown before the foundation of the world, but has appeared in these last times for the sake of you.”

Heb. 4:15, “For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin.”

Heb. 9:3, “Behind the second veil there was a tabernacle which is called the Holy of Holies,

Heb. 9:4, “having a golden altar of incense and the ark of the covenant covered on all sides with gold, in which was a golden jar holding the manna, and Aaron’s rod which budded, and the tables of the covenant;”

1 Kings 8:9, “There was nothing in the ark except the two tablets of stone which Moses put there at Horeb, where the LORD made a covenant with the sons of Israel, when they came out of the land of Egypt.”

**Ex. 16:4, “Then the LORD said to Moses,
‘Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you;
and the people shall go out and gather a day’s
portion every day, that I may test them,
whether or not they will walk in My
instruction’.”**

Psa. 78:24, “He rained down manna upon them to eat and gave them food from heaven.

Psa. 78:25, “Man did eat the bread of angels; He sent them food in abundance.”

Num. 21:5, “The people spoke against God and Moses, ‘Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and no water, and we loathe this miserable food’.”

1 Cor. 10:1, “For I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that our fathers were all under the cloud and all passed through the sea;

1 Cor. 10:2, “and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea;

1 Cor. 10:3, “and all ate the same spiritual food

1 Cor. 10:4, “and all drank the same spiritual drink, for they were drinking from a spiritual rock which followed them; and the rock was Christ.”
