








#### Herod's "Second" Temple on the Temple Mount

King Herod the Great began renovations on the Second Temple approximately 20-19 BC. The entire temple expansion, including the massive Temple Mount, was not completed until approximately 62-64 AD, only to be destroyed by the Romans in 70 AD.










## **Literal Prophecy–Literal Fulfillment**

Matt. 2:5, "So they said to him, 'In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it is written by the prophet: Matt. 2:6, " 'But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are not the least among the rulers of Judah; for out of you shall come a Ruler who will shepherd My people Israel.' "

Mic. 5:2, "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of you shall come forth to Me the One to be Ruler in Israel, whose goings forth are from of old, from everlasting." Matt. 2:15, "and was there until the death of Herod, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying, 'Out of Egypt I called My Son.'"

Hos. 11:1, "When Israel was a child, I loved him, and out of Egypt I called My son."

## **Literal History–Application**

Matt. 2:17, "Then was fulfilled what was spoken by Jeremiah the prophet, saying: Matt. 2:18, " 'A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, weeping, and great mourning, Rachel weeping for her children, refusing to be comforted, because they are no more.' "

Jer. 31:15, "Thus says the LORD: 'A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation and bitter weeping, Rachel weeping for her children, refusing to be comforted for her children, because they are no more.'"

### The Day of the Lord Time of Jacob's Trouble, Jer. 30:8

**Call to Turn** שוב *shuv* gal impera masc plur to return

Joel 2:12, " 'Now, therefore,' " says the LORD, 'Turn to Me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning.' "

Joel 2:13, "So rend your heart, and not your garments; return to the LORD your God, for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness; and He relents from doing harm."

### **Context of Joel 2**

Deut. 30:2, "and you return to the LORD your God and obey His voice, according to all that I command you today, you and your children, with all your heart and with all your soul,"

### **Context of Joel 2**

Ezek. 36:26, "I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.
