The Epistle to the ROMANS



**Rom. 3:9, “What then? Are we better than they?
Not at all. For we have previously charged both
Jews and Greeks that they are all under sin.”**

Rom. 3:10, “As it is written: ‘There is none righteous, no, not one;

**Rom. 3:11,
“ ‘There is none who understands; There is none who seeks after God.**

Rom. 3:12, “ ‘They have all turned aside; They have together become unprofitable; There is none who does good, no, not one.’ ”

Psa. 14:1, “The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good.

Psa. 14:2, “The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God.

Psa. 14:3, “They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that doeth good, no, not one.”

Ecclesiastes 7:20, “For there is not a just [צַדִּיק] *tzaddiq* man on earth who does good and does not sin.”

“Their throat is an open tomb; with their tongues they have practiced deceit”;**

NKJV

Psa. 5:9, “For there is no faithfulness in their mouth; Their inward part is destruction; Their throat is an open tomb; They flatter with their tongue.”

LXX

Psalm 5:9, “For there is no truth in their mouth; their heart is vain;
their throat is an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit.”

Rom. 3:13a,
“Their throat is an open tomb; with their tongues they have practiced deceit”;

Heykal (הֵיכָל) (Psa 5:7b) is also used of the tabernacle (cf. 1 Sam. 1:9; 3:3).

NKJV

Psa. 140:3,

“They sharpen their tongues like a serpent; the poison of asps is under their lips. Selah”

LXX

Psalm 139:3,

“They have sharpened their tongue as the tongue of a serpent; the poison of asps is under their lips. Pause.”

Rom. 3:13b,

... “The poison of asps is under their lips”;

NKJV

Psa. 10:7,

“His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and oppression; Under his tongue is trouble and iniquity.”

LXX

Psa 9:27,

“Whose mouth is full of cursing, and bitterness, and fraud: under his tongue are trouble and pain.”

Rom. 3:14,

“Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness.”

NKJV

Isa. 59:7, “Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood; Their thoughts are thoughts of iniquity; Wasting and destruction are in their paths.

Isa. 59:8, “The way of peace they have not known, and there is no justice in their ways; they have made themselves crooked paths; whoever takes that way shall not know peace.”

LXX

Isaiah 59:7, “And their feet run to wickedness, swift to shed blood; their thoughts also are thoughts of murder; destruction and misery are in their ways;

Isaiah 59:8, “and the way of peace they know not, neither is there judgment in their ways; for their paths by which they go are crooked, and they know not peace.”

Rom. 3:15, “Their feet are swift to shed blood;

Rom. 3:16, “Destruction and misery are in their ways;

Rom. 3:17, “And the way of peace they have not known.”
