GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS & GRACE

Rom. 15:7, “Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God.

Rom. 15:8, “Now I say that Jesus Christ has become a servant to the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made to the fathers,

Rom. 15:9, “and that the Gentiles might glorify God for His mercy, as it is written: ‘*For this reason I will confess to You among the Gentiles, and sing to Your name.*’

Rom. 15:10, “And again he says: ‘*Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people!*’

Rom. 15:11, “And again: ‘*Praise the LORD, all you Gentiles! Laud Him, all you peoples!*’

Rom. 15:12, “And again, Isaiah says: ‘*There shall be a root of Jesse; and He who shall rise to reign over the Gentiles, in Him the Gentiles shall hope.*’

Rom. 15:13, “Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.”

Rom. 15:8, “Now [FOR (*gar*)] I say that Jesus Christ has become a servant to the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made to the fathers,”

Gal. 3:16, “Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, ‘And to seeds,’ as of many, but as of one, ‘And to your Seed,’ who is Christ.”

Gen. 22:17, “blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply your descendants [seed, corporate] as the stars of the heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their [HIS, 3s pronoun] enemies.

Gen. 22:18, “In your seed [seed, singular] all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.”

Rom. 15:9, “and that the Gentiles might glorify God for His mercy, as it is written: *‘For this reason I will confess to You among the Gentiles, and sing to Your name.*’ ”

Psa. 18:2, “The LORD is my rock [*sela*] and my fortress [*metzuda*] and my deliverer; My God, my strength [stronghold, bulwark] in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold [refuge in the heights].

Psa. 18:3, “I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised; so shall I be saved from my enemies.”



Psa. 18:46, “The LORD lives! Blessed be my Rock! Let the God of my salvation be exalted.

Psa. 18:47, “It is God who avenges me, and subdues the peoples under me;

Psa. 18:48, “He delivers me from my enemies. You also lift me up above those who rise against me; You have delivered me from the violent man.

Psa. 18:49, “Therefore I will give thanks to You, O LORD, among the Gentiles, and sing praises to Your name.

Psa. 18:50, “Great deliverance He gives to His king, and shows mercy to His anointed, to David and his descendants forevermore.”

Deut. 32:43, “Rejoice, *O Gentiles*, with His people; for He will avenge the blood of His servants, and render vengeance to His adversaries; He will provide atonement for His land and His people.”

Rom. 15:11, “And again: ‘*Praise the LORD, all you Gentiles! Laud Him, all you peoples!*’ ”
