Matt. 7:8, “For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.


Matt. 7:9, “Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone?

2 Chron. 1:7, “On that night God appeared to Solomon, and said to him, ‘Ask! What shall I give you?’ ”

Joel 2:29, “And also on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days.

Joel 2:32, “And it shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the LORD has said, among the remnant whom the LORD calls.”

1 John 5:14, “Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

1 John 5:15, “And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.”
