

1. What does “Lord” mean?

κύριος *kurios*— lord, master, the Lord

A person who is in charge, an owner of a property or business.

A person in authority.

Of the Creator God of the Hebrew Scriptures.

Lord = Old Testament LORD [YHWH יהוה]

Genesis was written approximately 1405 BC. But the recording of the prophecy was made much earlier in the records Moses used. The prophecy was made at the time of Adam’s sin.

What are the probabilities?

The probabilities of only eight of these prophecies coming true.

“We find that the chance that any man might have lived down to the present time and fulfilled all eight prophecies is 1 in 10^{17} ” (10 to the 17th power). That would be 1 in 100,000,000,000,000,000 (17 zeros after the one).

“Now these prophecies were either given by inspiration of God or the prophets just wrote them as they thought they should be. In such a case the prophets had just one chance in 10^{17} of having them come true in any man, but they all came true in Christ. This means that the fulfillment of these eight prophecies alone proves that God inspired the writing of those prophecies to a definiteness which lacks only one chance in 10^{17} of being absolute.”

We find the chance that any one man fulfilled all 48 prophecies to be 1 in 10^{157} . This is really a large number and it represents an extremely small chance.
