Jesus and Pilate discussion - John 18:37-38 ESV

Then Pilate said to him, "So you are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say that I am a king. For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world—to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice." Pilate said to him, "What is truth?"



Truth – Do we care?

If someone answered your questions about Christianity to the point that it seemed true beyond a reasonable doubt, would you become a Christian?

If no then your resistance is emotional not intellectual Most doubt is emotional – we don't want it to be true.



Truth

- Correspondence theory the statement is true if it corresponds to reality.
 - This is the only theory of truth that can be used consistently because it is true!
- Aristotle "To say of what is that it is not, or of what is not that it is, is false, while to say of what is that it is, and of what is not that it is not, is true; so that he who says of anything that it is, or that it is not, will say either what is true or what is false."



SIX Truths about Truth

- Truth is discovered, not invented. It exists independent of anyone's knowledge of it.
 - Gravity existed prior to Newton.
- Truth is transcultural; if something is true, it is true for all people, in all places, at all times.
 - 2+2=4 for everyone, everywhere, every time.
- Truth is unchanging even though our beliefs about truth change.
 - Earth has always been round.



SIX Truths about Truth

- Beliefs cannot change a fact, no matter how sincerely they are held.
 - The belief I can fly does not make it true.
- Truth is not affected by the attitude of the one professing it.
 - An arrogant person does not make it false.
- All truths are absolute truths.
 - There are no relative truths.



Truth is Not Ice Cream


- Subjective true only for the person speaking
 - Personal preference
 - Neither right or wrong (True or False)
- Objective true for the object
 - Preferences don't matter
 - Either right or wrong (True or False)
- Christianity is claiming to be Objectively true
- Stop relativizing Christianity

"My religious belief is that all religious beliefs are <u>not</u> true. Is my belief true?"




Can all Religions be True?

- All religious beliefs cannot be true because many religious beliefs are contradictory.
 - World religions have more contradictory beliefs than complementary ones.
- They disagree on virtually every major issue, including the nature of God, the nature of man, sin, salvation, heaven, hell and creation.

Twelve Point Argument for Christianity

- 1. Truth about reality is knowable.
- 2. Opposites cannot both be true.
- 3. The theistic God exists.
- 4.If God exists, then miracles are possible.
- 5. Miracles can be used to confirm a message from God.
- 6. The New Testament is historically reliable.
- 7. The New Testament says that Jesus claimed to be God.
- 8.Jesus' claim to be God is confirmed by miracles.
- 9. Therefore, Jesus is God.
- 10. Whatever Jesus (who is God) teaches is true.
- 11. Jesus taught that the Bible is the Word of God.
- 12. Therefore, it is true that the Bible is the Word of God (Anything opposed to it is false)



How Reason can lead to God

- Take everything that exists "the Blob of everything"
 - Nothing outside the Blob could account for the Blob
- The blob is full of dependent things things that rely on something else for their existence.
 - But how do we account for the Blob if it is full of ONLY dependent things the Blob cannot depend on anything for its own existence.
- There must be some FOUNDATION that has an independent, self-sufficient, NECESSARY, nature.
 - It is the sort of thing that MUST exist therefore it must be ETERNAL



How Reason Can Lead To God

- This FOUNDATION must be all powerful
 - Because the foundation could not receive its power from something outside the BLOB it must have a power that exists by its own nature.
 - This power must be eternal.
- What is one thing in the Blob YOU! What kind of thing are you? Four Characteristics of Humans that must be accounted for:
 - Minds Can physical particles produce minds?
 - Complex Bodies you are basically information (DNA).
 - Moral Agents What best describes our moral landscape and our experience of it?
 - Rational Agents Where does reason come from? Could reason come from non-reason?



How Reason Can Lead To God

- What this all points to is that at the bottom of ALL reality (foundation)
 must be a RATIONAL, Mind-Like being with a MORAL Nature.
- Inference to the best explanation What best explains all the data?
 - Our worldview must be coherent, cannot contain contradictions and must be able to explain all the data.
- This FOUNDATION would also be PERFECT
 - It must have NO defects or imperfections
 - It cannot possibly be improved
- Thus by pure reason we have arrived at the greatest possible treasure, the self-sufficient, eternally powerful, supremely rational and perfectly good, CREATOR GOD



How this helps

- Any view of God that is less than that CANNOT account for all reality.
 - Any material GOD CANNOT account for all reality.
- We can go further The Kalam Cosmological Argument
 - Every Effect has a Cause
 - The universe came into existence (is an effect)
 - The universe has a cause
- The theory of General Relativity tells us that time, space and matter are co-relative you can't have one without the other.
 - So if time, space and matter came into existence at the Big Bang ---- then the cause of the Big Bang would have to be timeless, spaceless and immaterial.










MAPS OF SCOTLAND









New Testament

- 27 different documents
- Written on 27 different scrolls
- 9 or 10 different authors (depending on who wrote Hebrews)
- Written over a 20-50 year period
- The individual writings have since been collected into one book we now call the Bible.
 - NT is thus not one source, but a collection of sources.



Original?

- We do not have the originals of any of the New Testament documents.
 - Is that a problem?
- Manuscripts copies of the originals and copies of the copies etc...
 - We want early and abundant manuscripts
- The NT manuscripts that we have are better supported than the best ten pieces of classical literature combined.




Years Between Date Written and Earliest Fragment or Manuscript

More Manuscripts

- There are around 6,000 handwritten Greek manuscripts of NT.
 - In addition there are over 18,000 manuscripts in other languages.
- Some manuscripts are complete Bibles, some are complete books, some are pages, some are scraps.
- Next closest is the Illiad by Homer 1900 manuscripts.



Earlier Manuscripts

- John Rylands fragment Earliest undisputed manuscript is segment of John 18:31-33, 37-38.
- Dated between A.D. 117-138 (some say earlier).
- There are 9 disputed fragments that date from A.D. 50 70 found with the Dead Sea Scrolls.



Earlier Manuscripts

- Most of the NT, including all of the Gospels, survives from A.D. 250.
- Codex Vaticanus manuscript of the entire NT from about A.D. 325.
- Several other complete manuscripts survive from this century.
 - Textual indicators suggest they are in a family of manuscripts that can be traced back to A.D. 100 150.



More Abundantly Supported

- Even if Diocletian was successful, we could reconstruct the entire NT from the early church father's quotations.
 - They quoted the NT so much (36,289 times) that all but eleven verses of the NT can be reconstructed just from their quotations.









No Original?

- Why could this be a better scenario than having the original?
- Speculation



Skeptic

- There are over 200,000 errors in the Bible.
 - Not errors but variants
 - Vast majority are grammatical
 - Spread throughout the 5,700+ manuscripts
- Westcott and Hort estimated that only 1 in 60 variants have any significance.
 - This would leave a text 98.33% pure
- Metzger 99.5% accurate
 - .5% in question doesn't affect a single doctrine of the Christian faith.



Fact #1. Yeshua Died by Crucifixion

- Flavius Josephus Jewish/Roman Historian 1st century CE
- Tacitus 56AD-120AD Regarded as the greatest Roman historian
- Lucian 125 AD to 180 AD Roman Satirist
- Babylonian Talmud 6th Century AD
- 6 additional critically accepted ancient sources



Josephus 37 CE - 100 CE

- Stated that Yeshua was crucified during the reign of Tiberius by the Prefect Pontius Pilate (Antiquities 18:63)
- Recorded Yakov, brother of Yeshua (called the Messiah), being Brought before the Sanhedrin for stoning.

(Antiquities 20:200)


Therefore, to stop the rumor, Nero substituted as culprits and punished in the utmost refinements of cruelty, a class of men loathed for their vices, whom the crowd styled Christians. Christus, the founder of the name, had undergone the deather penalty in the reign of Tiberius by sentence of the procurator Pontius Pilatus, and the pernicious superstition was checked for a moment, only to break out once more, not merely in Judea, the home of the disease, but in the capital itself, where all things horrible or shameful in the world collect and find a vogue.



Tacitus

- Christians are named after their founder, "Christus" Messiah
- This "Christus" died by State death penalty during Emperor Tiberius' Reign 14-37 AD under direction of Pontius Pilate
- · His death did not put an end to the "pernicious superstition"
- Followers and Superstition spread to Rome

Lucian 2nd century Greek Satirist

"The Christians, you know, worship a man to this day- the distinguished personage who introduced their novel rites and was crucified on that account . . . You see, these misguided creatures start with the general condition that they are immortal for all time, which explains the contempt of death and voluntary self-devotion which are so common among them, and then it was impressed on them by their original lawgiver that they are all brothers, from the moment that they are converted, and deny the gods of Greece, and worship the crucified sage, and live after his laws."

Yeshu was hanged on Passover Eve. Forty days previously, the herald had cried, "He is being led out for stoning because he has practiced sorcery and led Israel astray and enticed them into apostasy.  - States that most of the events in the ancient world depend on one
 - Witness. Two witnesses make an event unimpeachable.

Alexander the Great BCE 350

• The earliest reference is 300 years after his death

• BEST sources are by Plutark and Arian 425-450 years after his death



Tiberius Ceasar dies 1 cent. CE

• Best account of his existence is by Tacitus in AD 110. 80 years after his death.

• Next best is Diokasus 180 years after his death



Early Eye Witness Testimony

- Bart Ehrman (agnostic) states that the creed found in I Corinthians 15:3 dates I to 2 years after the Crucifixion.
- James DG Dunn, prof. NT U of Durahm: Dates creed to within 6 months of Crucifixion
- Gospels and epistles were all written in the 1st century, with oral transmission by eyewitnesses extending into the 2nd century.



The crucifixion is arguably the most well documented event in ancient history!



Fact #2 Empty Tomb


Critically accepted that the Tomb was Empty



Critical Explanations?

- Disciples stole the Body . . .
- People went to the wrong tomb . . .
- Yeshua was never buried: acknowledges his death, and now has to deal with resurrection.
- Swoon Theory: professional killers don't know how to kill. Only one example of someone surviving crucifixion, and he was taken off the cross with two others who still died.
- Merely a copy-cat legend of Mythros, Osirus

Followers believed they had seen the risen Yeshua



Peter, Jakob, Paul - Martyrs

• All three were killed for holding fast to Yeshua being raised from death.

• All three knew for certain whether or not Yeshua was really raised from death.

• What about Islamic martyrs?



What do skeptical scholars say?

- Dale Allison- Princeton Theological: "I'm a skeptic, but I'm sure the risen Jesus appeared to his disciples after his death."
- EP Sanders Duke U. Historian: "The following is a historical fact, 'The earliest disciples saw the risen Jesus. I don't know how they saw him, but they saw the risen Jesus."



Fact #4

Changed lives of Saul and Jakob



- Jakob- Yeshua's brother did not follow him during his ministry and even taunted him. Mk 3:2131-34, 6:3; Jn 7:1-10
- Jakob and brother were with Yeshua in the upper room after the Resurrection. Acts 1:14
- Jakob- Leader of Jerusalem Church
- Paul reported his activities to James
- Jakob died a martyr's death (Josephus)



- Saul/Paul a former persecutor of followers of Yeshua made a complete 180 in belief and practice to become the most prolific writer of the NT
- Dies a Martyr's death in Rome historically by beheading

• What explains such radical behavior?
