









Now therefore, please, let me strike him at once with the spear, right to the earth; and I will not have to strike him a second time!'

<u>1 Sam. 26:9</u>, "But David said to Abishai, 'Do not destroy him; for who can stretch out his hand against the LORD'S anointed, and be guiltless?'



If the kings sin, they will be disciplined, but David's dynasty will survive.




David's house, kingdom and throne will be in Jerusalem forever.

Immediate:

David's son rules after him. Solomon builds the Temple. Solomon is not perfect and will sin, God will discipline him, but God will remain faithful to His covenant.

Future:

God will provide His Messiah.



<u>1 Chron. 29:23</u>, "Then Solomon sat on the throne of the LORD as king instead of David his father, and prospered; and all Israel obeyed him."

D. Adultery and Murder

<u>2 Sam. 11:1</u>, "It happened in the spring of the year, at the time when kings go out to battle, that David sent Joab and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the people of Ammon and besieged Rabbah. But David remained at Jerusalem.

<u>2 Sam. 11:2</u>, "Then it happened one evening that David arose from his bed and walked on the roof of the king's house. And from the roof he saw a woman bathing, and the woman was very beautiful to behold."
