


I. The Third and Final King of Israel as a Unified Kingdom: Solomon

A. Asked God for wisdom (1 Kings 3)

- 1 Kings 3:5, "At Gibeon the LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream by night; and God said, 'Ask! What shall I give you?'
- 1 Kings 3:6, "And Solomon said: 'You have shown great mercy to Your servant David my father, because he walked before You in truth, in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with You; You have continued this great kindness for him, and You have given him a son to sit on his throne, as it is this day.
- 1 Kings 3:7, "'Now, O LORD my God, You have made Your servant king instead of my father David, but I am a little child; I do not know how to go out or come in.'"

- 1 Kings 3:8, " 'And Your servant is in the midst of Your people whom You have chosen, a great people, too numerous to be numbered or counted.
- 1 Kings 3:9, " 'Therefore give to Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people, that I may discern between good and evil. For who is able to judge this great people of Yours?'
- 1 Kings 3:10, "The speech pleased the LORD, that Solomon had asked this thing."

- 1 Kings 3:11, "Then God said to him: 'Because you have asked this thing, and have not asked long life for yourself, nor have asked riches for yourself, nor have asked the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself understanding to discern justice,
- 1 Kings 3:12, "'behold, I have done according to your words; see, I have given you a wise and understanding heart, so that there has not been anyone like you before you, nor shall any like you arise after you.
- 1 Kings 3:13, "'And I have also given you what you have not asked: both riches and honor, so that there shall not be anyone like you among the kings all your days.'"

What is "Wisdom?"

General definition:

Wisdom is the ability to judge what is true and right and apply it to life's decisions so we can live skillfully for God.



- Ex. 28:3, "So you shall speak to all who are gifted artisans, whom I have filled with the spirit of wisdom, that they may make Aaron's garments, to consecrate him, that he may minister to Me as priest."
- Ex. 31:3, "And I have filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship,"
- Ex. 31:6, "And I, indeed I, have appointed with him Aholiab the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan; and I have put wisdom in the hearts of all the gifted artisans, that they may make all that I have commanded you:"
- Ex. 35:26, "And all the women whose hearts stirred with wisdom spun yarn of goats' hair."

Ex. 35:35, "He has filled them with skill to do all manner of work of the engraver and the designer and the tapestry maker, in blue, purple, and scarlet thread, and fine linen, and of the weaver—those who do every work and those who design artistic works."

Ex. 36:1, "And Bezalel and Aholiab, and every gifted artisan in whom the LORD has put wisdom and understanding, to know how to do all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, shall do according to all that the LORD has commanded."

Biblical wisdom is deeply related to God as Creator.

Prov. 1:20, "Wisdom calls aloud outside; She raises her voice in the open squares."


The use of personification.

Personification is <u>a figure of speech</u> where an abstract idea or a concrete inanimate object is depicted as a person in order to enhance the significance of the idea or the impact of something. For example, "all my bones shall say" (Psa. 35:10) personifies "bones" as having their own emotions to illustrate the negative impact of some spiritual or mental event. God is eternally omniscient, and this knowledge was demonstrated in God's skillful artistry in His creation of the universe.


Thus "wisdom" is viewed as if it is created, but it is in the creation itself that creatures can see and understand God's skillful application of His knowledge. We see His design, artistry, and beauty in all of His creation. Prov. 8:22, "The LORD possessed me at the beginning of His way, before His works of old.

Prov. 8:23, "I have been <u>established</u> from everlasting, from the beginning, before there was ever an earth."



- Prov. 9:2, "She has slaughtered her meat, she has mixed her wine, she has also furnished her table.
- Prov. 9:3, "She has sent out her maidens, she cries out from the highest places of the city,
- Prov. 9:4, "'Whoever is simple, let him turn in here!' As for him who lacks understanding, she says to him,
- Prov. 9:5, "Come, eat of my bread and drink of the wine I have mixed.
- Prov. 9:6, "Forsake foolishness and live, and go in the way of understanding.
- Prov. 9:7, "He who corrects a scoffer gets shame for himself, and he who rebukes a wicked man only harms himself."

120,000 sheep

The logistics of the sacrifices:

22,000 cattle in 12 days = 1,833/day (Sabbath off)


152.7/hour or 2.5 cattle/minute

833 sheep/hour = 13.89 sheep/minute or 1 about every 4 seconds

Avg. weight: 1000 lbs, 90 lbs of blood (10.8 gal per cattle)

22,000 cattle @1,000 lbs would yield 237,600 gal blood

That is just under 20,000 gal blood/day (19,796 gal)


The logistics of the sacrifices:

120,000 sheep in 12 days = 10,000/day

10,000 per day / 12 hours = 833/hour

833 sheep/hour = 13.89 sheep/minute or 1 about every 4 seconds

Avg. weight: 50 lbs, 4.5 lbs of blood (0.54 gal/sheep) 120,000 sheep would yield 64,800 gal blood 10,000 sheep would shed at least 54 gal blood a day or about 90 gal/hour

Totals

250,000s gal blood which would fill about a dozen railroad tank cars holding bout 25,000 gallons each.

The rumen, the storage stomach

In cattle: 40–50 gallons

Sheep: 1 gallon

Approximately 120,000 gallons of sheep GI contents Approximately 1,320,000 gallons of cattle GI waste

Net:

The 120,000 sheep yield about 3,000,000 pounds of meat (120,000 × 50 lbs × 50%) and about 120,000 gallons of gastro-intestinal waste.

The 22,000 cattle yield about 13,000,000 pounds of beef (22,000 × 1000 lbs × 60%) plus about 1,320,000 gallons of gastro-intestinal waste.



1 Kings 9:8, "'And as for this house, which is exalted, everyone who passes by it will be astonished and will hiss, and say, "Why has the LORD done thus to this land and to this house?"

1 Kings 9:9, "'Then they will answer, "Because they forsook the LORD their God, who brought their fathers out of the land of Egypt, and have embraced other gods, and worshiped them and served them; therefore the LORD has brought all this calamity on them."'
