

The New Covenant - Jeremiah 31:31-36

- Not like the Mosaic Covenant, 31-32
- His law will be in their minds and hearts, 33a
- He will be their God and they His people, 33b
- They will all know Him, 34a
- Their sins will be forgiven, 34b
- It is as certain as the sun, moon, stars, and sea, 35-36

"The Deliverer will come out of Zion,


And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob;
