- Over 60 pastors, church leaders and missionaries in attendance.
- Elber joined us as a teaching partner for the first time
- Covered many problematic verses : Context, Context, Context
- Source material : Chafer Hermeneutics, Roy Zuck "Basic Bible Interpretation , DM2 Bible Study Methods

Matthew 18:20 (NIV): *"For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them."*

Taken out of context: Used to suggest that Jesus' presence is conditional on a specific number of people gathering together.

Context: Jesus is speaking about church discipline and the authority of believers to resolve conflicts in this context.

Revelation 3:20 (NIV): *"Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me."*

Taken out of context: Often used in evangelism to imply that Jesus is knocking at the heart of an unbeliever's door, waiting for them to let Him in.

Context: Jesus is speaking to the church at Laodicea, calling complacent believers to restoration of Fellowship. This verse is a call to lukewarm Christians to renew their relationship with Him, not an initial invitation to unbelievers.

Ministry Screening Process for partner teachers

We follow a four-step process for screening teaching candidates:

- 1) They are required to attend two consecutive conferences.
- 2) They must have a testimony from fellow believers affirming that they conduct themselves in a manner worthy of our calling.
- 3) They must successfully pass Artios ministries 40-question screening and assessment.
- 4) They must demonstrate the ability to teach effectively and have completed our Hermeneutics course*

* Or equivalent

Question: Define and explain the Greek word πιστεύω (pisteuō) for believe, and how does it relate to justification in the context of John 3:16?

Question: Define and explain the Greek ἵλασμός (hilasmos) propitiation in the context of 1 John 2:2.

Question: If you were to die tomorrow, would you go to Heaven and be with Jesus?

Expanded to more than twenty churches in the Natal Area

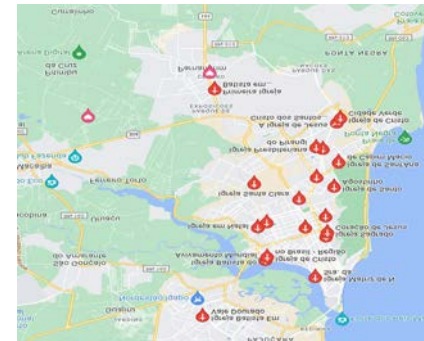
Expanded to neighboring cities and states
